

FEEDBACK REPORT 2022-23

Collecting feedback from the stakeholders is most important for the success of every institution. All these feedbacks were analyzed by using a five-point rating scale. The maximum score is 5 and the minimum score is one, where 5 indicates highly satisfied, four means satisfied, 3 indicates neutral, 2 indicates dissatisfied and 1 indicates highly dissatisfied.

FEEDBACK – ALUMNI

Analysis of the alumni feedback for the year 2022-2023 revealed the following.

- Most of the alumni are satisfied with the course content and admits that the course content was rather pertinent in their jobs. The score obtained is 3.4/5.
- The career-oriented syllabus was quite helpful for them to find out an employment soon after their graduation/post-graduation (3.5/5).
- Moreover, these stake holders are highly satisfied with the quality of teaching which is revealed by a higher score of 4.5.
- The college has a positive and balanced academic atmosphere (score:4.2) that enabled them to be successful in their life.
- Most of the students are satisfied with the accessibility of reference books which is revealed through a score of 4.1/5.
- The alumni feedback also revealed that the institution supports higher learning with a score of 4.05/5 and the curriculum provided in the college also fosters the entrepreneurial skills of the student(score:4.05).

TEACHERS FEEDBACK

Teacher being the most important factor in curriculum design, implementation and development, feedback of teacher on curricular aspects are of utmost importance. Analysis of the teacher feedback for the year 2020-2021 brought about the following information.

- The value given by teacher for the curriculum related activities of the college is 4/5
- Most of the teachers are satisfied with the course content (4/5).
- To most of them there is clarity in course objectives which is revealed by a score of 4.2/5.
- It is also revealed the syllabus is enriched with the inclusion of advanced topics (3.5/5).
- The score obtained for the availability of instructional is 3.8/5 which indicates that they are getting enough instructional hours to complete the syllabus

- The curriculum presently following curriculum is career-oriented to most(3.5/5).
- All most all of them are contented with the availability of teaching resources and reference text in the institution(4.5/5).
- To some of them curriculum is providing an opportunity for applied learning (3.2/5).
- Most of them have the opinion that the curriculum has the capacity to support students in their higher learning 4.2/5.

STUDENT FEEDBACK

The feedback taken from students about the present syllabus and curriculum of the college reveals the following facts:

- Most of the students have the opinion that the course content should have job relevance (3.5/5).
- The present syllabus is career-oriented according to most of the (3.9) students.
- Most of the students are satisfied with the quality of teaching (4.5/5).
- The overall academic atmosphere of the college is satisfactory to most of the students (4.2/5).
- It is also observed that the students courses are satisfied with the reference materials available in the college (4.4/5).
- The curriculum is capable of supporting students in their higher studies (3.9/5).
- Moreover, it has also been observed that the curriculum had the ability to foster entrepreneurial skills among the students(3.7/5).

EMPLOYER FEEDBACK

The feedback taken from employer about the present syllabus and curriculum of the college reveals the following facts:

- Most of the employer have the opinion that the course content should have job relevance (4.2/5).
- According to the most of the employer, the present syllabus should add career-oriented content (4/5).
- The curriculum is capable of supporting the employee in his/her job (3.9/5).
- Moreover, it has also been observed that the curriculum had the ability to foster entrepreneurial skills among the employee (3.6/5).



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
