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Action Take Report on AAA Committee Recommendations (2021-22)

As per Recommendation given by AAA committee 2021-22, following action has been taken-

- 1. Recommendation** - The number of skilled based certificate courses be increased
Action Taken- There were 20 different certificate courses in the session 2021-22. The following 5 certificate courses are added in the session 2022-23. These certificate courses are as follows- 1) Certificate course in value Education 2) Certificate course in Hardware And Networking 3) Certificate course in basic of Computer Fundamentals 4) Certificate course in Chemistry Laboratory Safety Measures. 5) Certificate course in Teaching Methodology in Mathematics
- 2. Recommendation** - Arrange activities for women empowerment
Action Taken- The college organized a workshop focusing on "Women Empowerment through Self-Help Groups and Home Industries." The workshop aimed at promoting economic independence and entrepreneurship among women. The event was held in Ramanujan Hall and received active participation. (26th November 2022)The Women Empowerment Cell conducted a virtual conference on "Prospects of Women Empowerment in the Present Era," emphasizing the importance of empowering women in today's society. (26th January 2023)A program addressing the issue of superstition among women was held, with Dr. Hemant Wanjari presiding. The keynote speakers were Hon. Shri P.S. Khandare and Dr. P.S. Patil. (7th October 2022)
- 3. Recommendation** - Activities for environment sustainability be arranged
Action Taken- A unique program titled "Waste from Best" was organized to teach students how to create art from waste materials. The program was coordinated by the Marathi and Arts Department and was guided by Shweta Patil from Hingoli. (24th April 2023)
The NSS unit organized a campaign to promote a plastic-free environment. Students were educated on the adverse effects of plastic pollution and the importance of sustainable practices. (15th October 2022) The Department of Botany organized an excursion tour to Chikhaldara, where students observed plant diversity(21st to 22nd September 2022).
- 4. Recommendation** - To organize conferences and workshop for promotion of research activities
Action Taken- The Women Empowerment Cell conducted a virtual conference on "Prospects of Women Empowerment in the Present Era," emphasizing the importance of empowering women in today's society. The college also hosted several guest lectures, including one on "Recent Advances in Botany" (2nd May 2023) and another on "Advanced Information Technology" (11th September 2022). Workshop on Research Methodology was also organized to promote research culture .

5. **Recommendation** - Workshop on NEP-2020 be organized

Action Taken- The Department of History organized a workshop for B.A. students on the New Educational Policy, highlighting changes in the history curriculum and the examination system. (1st October 2022)


6. **Recommendation** - To arrange programs to promote social awareness among the students

Action Taken- In collaboration with Rajasthan Education Society, Nehru Yuva Kendra, and HDFC Bank, the college organized a blood donation camp in memory of Pt. Jawaharlal Nehru. A total of 57 donors participated, making it a significant event in the district. (14th November 2022) The NSS unit conducted a virtual workshop on National Voting Day, educating students on the Indian Constitution and the voting process. (25th January 2023)

The NSS unit organized a campaign to promote a plastic-free environment. Students were educated on the adverse effects of plastic pollution and the importance of sustainable practices. (15th October 2022) International Yoga Day was celebrated with enthusiasm, with students and faculty participating in yoga sessions. (21st June 2022) Daily yoga and pranayama sessions were conducted as part of the NSS camp, focusing on physical and mental well-being. (24th February to 2nd March 2023)

7. **Recommendation** - Extracurricular activities be enhanced.

Action Taken- The Computer Science Association was inaugurated, featuring activities like dance performances, singing, and a musical chair competition. (24th March 2023) The Department of Commerce and Management organized a virtual Parents-Teacher meet, discussing various aspects of student life and college activities. (13th October 2022). The Zoology Association was inaugurated under the guidance of the college principal and the Head of the Zoology Department. The association organized various activities, including seminars, quizzes, and a poster competition on "Save Water, Save Life." • Art of Living Program (8th October 2022): The Department of English organized a program on the "Art of Living," featuring motivational speakers from Jeevan Vidya Mission. Cultural Committee Report: The Cultural Committee organized various programs, including the District Youth Festival on 11th October 2022, which featured events like youth dialogue, folk dance, and mobile photography competitions. The college also celebrated Tula Sankranti on 21st March 2023, highlighting the cultural heritage of the Banjara community.


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
